What is CLAT?

CLAT stands for **Common Law Admission Test**, an entrance exam for admission into undergraduate and postgraduate law programs at top law universities in India. It is a highly competitive exam that requires extensive preparation and knowledge of the exam pattern, syllabus, and important dates. This article covers everything you need to know about CLAT, from registration to exam dates, to help you prepare for this crucial exam.

Eligibility:

1. There will be no upper age limit for candidates appearing for UG Programme through the CLAT.
2. Candidates must secure the following minimum percentage of marks in their qualifying examination (i.e., 10+2 or an equivalent examination):
 - i. Forty-five per cent (45%) marks or its equivalent grade in case of candidates belonging to General / OBC / PWD / NRI / PIO / OCI categories
 - ii. Forty Percent (40%) marks or equivalent in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST categories.

TOPICS COVERED

The UG-CLAT focuses on evaluating the comprehension and reasoning skills and abilities of candidates. Overall, it is designed to be a test of aptitude and skills that are necessary for a legal education rather than prior knowledge, though prior knowledge occasionally may be useful to respond to questions in the Current Affairs including General Knowledge section.

The UG-CLAT is a 2-hour test, with 120 multiple-choice questions carrying 1 mark each and negative marking of 0.25 marks for every wrong answer.
