## What is CUET?

**Common University Entrance Test** also known as **CUET UG** is a national level entrance exam conducted by NTA for admission to UG courses offered by participating institutes. Introduced in 2022, the CUET exam aligns as a significant UG entrance examination, offering candidates a common platform for seeking admission to UG programs in top colleges/universities throughout India.

## Eligibility Criteria

Candidate must have passed any one of the following examinations to be eligible for CUET UG: Before the registration, Candidate need to ensure that you meet the CUET eligibility criteria defined by NTA and respective universities. CUET eligibility criteria defines the age limit, nationality & domicile criteria, qualification and minimum marks requirements in class 12 boards.

- There is **no age limit to apply for CUET exam**. Those who have cleared class 12 boards can apply for the exam irrespective of their age.
- There are **no minimum qualifying marks in Class 12 Boards to apply for CUET exam**.

## Exam Pattern

The CUET UG 2025 exam is divided into three sections:

S. No.	Parameters	CUET (UG) - 2025
1.	Total subjects	37 (13 Indian languages + 23 domain-specific subjects + 1 General Aptitude Test)
2.	Choice of Test Paper	Candidates may choose up to a maximum of five (05) subjects, including languages and the General Aptitude Test, irrespective of the subjects opted in class XII.
3.	Mode of the Exam	Computer Based Test (CBT) mode
4.	Total Questions	50 questions for each test paper. All questions are compulsory.
5.	Duration	Duration for each test paper would be 60 minutes.

## Marking Scheme:

The total marks of the CUET exam vary based on the subjects chosen and the slot allotted to the candidate. The CUET marking scheme as per NTA is as follows:

- ✓ For every correct answer marked: five marks: (+5)
- ✓ For every incorrect option marked: one mark: (-1)
- ✓ For unanswered/Marked for Review: no mark: (0)
